

Dear Angus Glen Resident,

The Angus Glen Ratepayers Association and the Town of Markham Operations department have been working together for the past 8 months on the resurfacing laneway issue in Angus Glen East Village. We are happy to announce that the laneways that were resurfaced last fall will be refinished to their original smooth state in June. This grind and repave process will restore the affected rear laneways to their original condition.

The two step process will take approximately two weeks to complete. The first step, grinding off the current surface to a depth of 1 ½ inches will commence on **Monday, June 13, 2011**. This work will be completed within the week, weather permitting.

The second step, repaving, will commence the following week of **June 20, 2011**. This work will be completed within the week, weather permitting.

Access to the rear laneways will be restricted to short periods of time. With this in mind, we have engaged our By-law department to permit overnight parking in the front of your home during the construction period. Normal by-law enforcement such as parking in front of fire hydrants, blocking laneways and parking restrictions to one side of the street will continue to be enforced. Work may begin as early as 7 am, so we ask that if you need to remove your vehicle from your garage after this time, please park on the road as you may not be able to remove your vehicle from your garage once work has begun on your laneway. Also, please notify any service providers that may be doing work on your roof and/or backyards that they will not have access to the laneways during this period.

We apologize for any inconvenience resulting from this scheduled work and we thank you for your patience and cooperation in this matter. If you have special access or mobility challenges, please notify the Contact Centre as soon as possible.
